What do you want others to know about medication safety?

Participant Worksheet: **Junior Pharmacist Flyer**

Directions: Today, you are a Junior Pharmacist! Your job is to help others learn how to stay safe with medicine by making a flyer. Be creative! Use messages and pictures you draw or cut out. Follow these steps:

- 1. Create a title.** Think of a catchy title and write it in the title box on your flyer.
- 2. Choose your first message.** Pick one medication safety rule, message, or Junior Pharmacist fact. Write it on the lines in the flyer.
- 3. Add pictures.** Draw pictures or cut and paste images that match your message in the space provided.
- 4. Choose a second message.** Pick another safety rule, message, or fact. Write it on the lines and add matching pictures.
- 5. Finish the bottom section.** Write or draw something important or interesting about medication safety that you want others to know.

Medication Safety Rule #1: Ask a trusted adult for help with medicine.

Messages (pick one to write)

“A trusted adult helps you take medicine safely.”

“A trusted adult is someone that cares for you and makes you feel safe.”



Medication Safety Rule #2: Only take medicine meant for you.

Messages (pick one to write)

“Medicine that helps one person might not be safe for another. Only take medicine meant for you.”

“Never share your medicine.”



Medication Safety Rule #3: Keep medicine in safe places.

Messages

“Store medicine up high or in locked spaces.”

“Keep medicine in its original container.”



Medication Safety Rule #4: Share medication safety with family and friends.

“Help others stay safe by sharing the medication safety rules.”
